Hospice of San Joaquin offers grief support groups for children in grades K – 6th periodically throughout the year. A day camp is offered in the fall. Children will have an opportunity to explore their feelings through a variety of mediums such as art, music, journaling, games, and storytelling. Groups are led by a Hospice of San Joaquin Bereavement staff member with assistance from trained Bereavement Volunteers.

Bereavement programs for children are offered free to the community, however, pre-registration is required and space is limited.
